The children have all had great fun and the outfits were amazing!



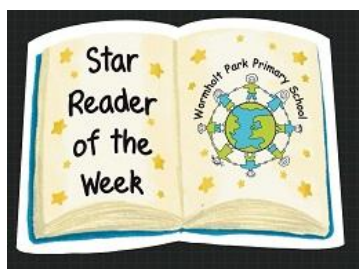








## Readers of the Week
