Police Workshops in Year 3 and Year 6



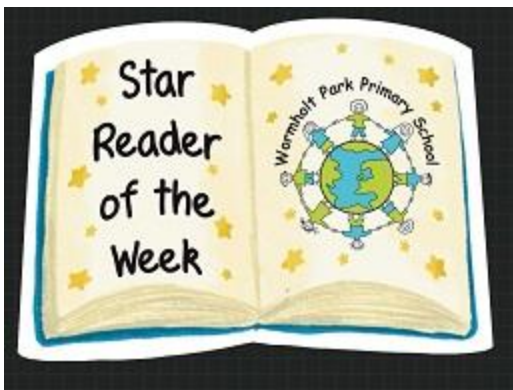

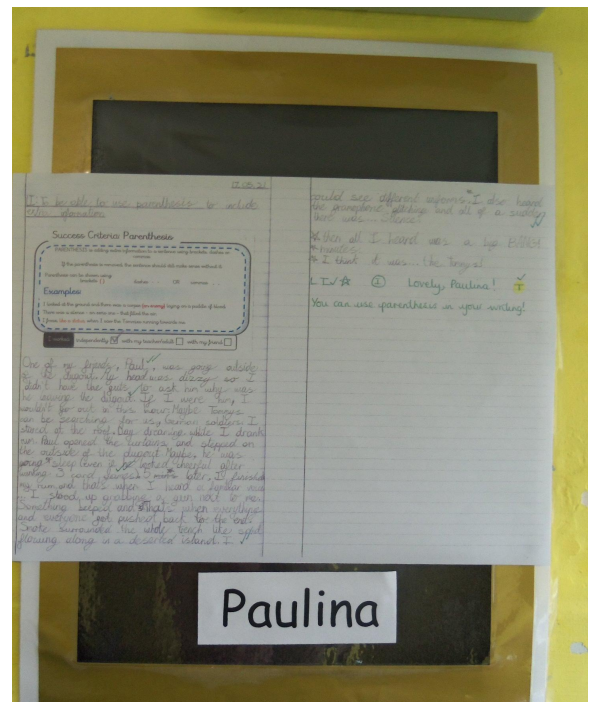
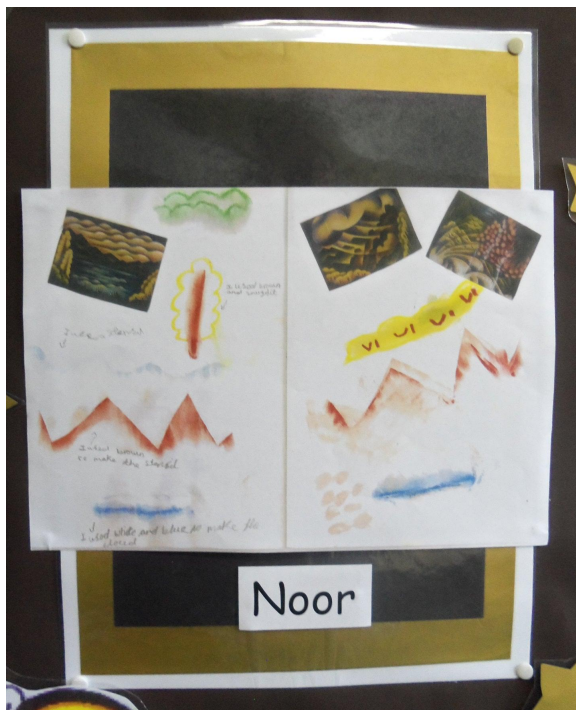
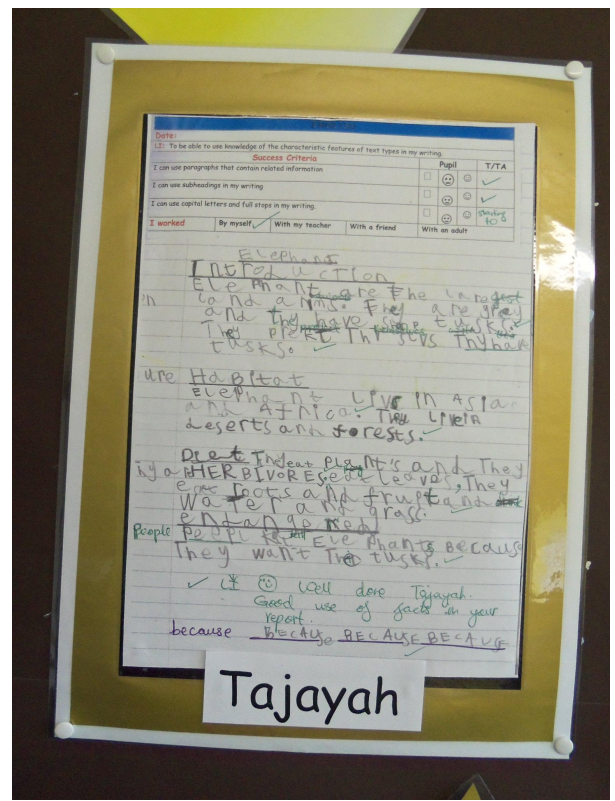
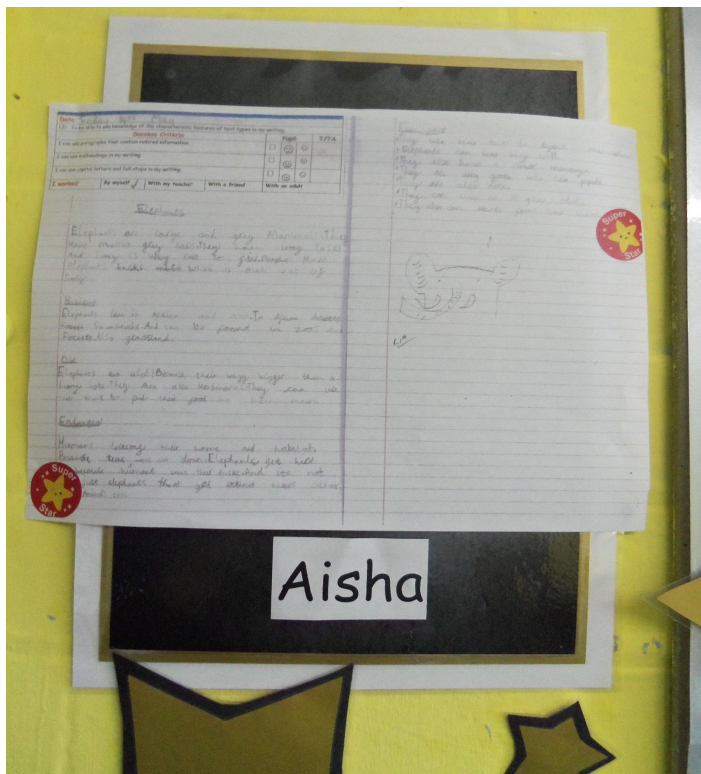


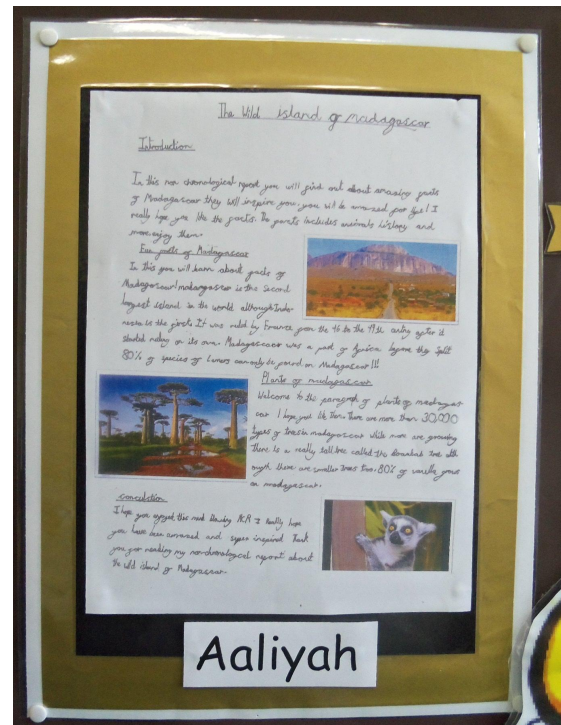
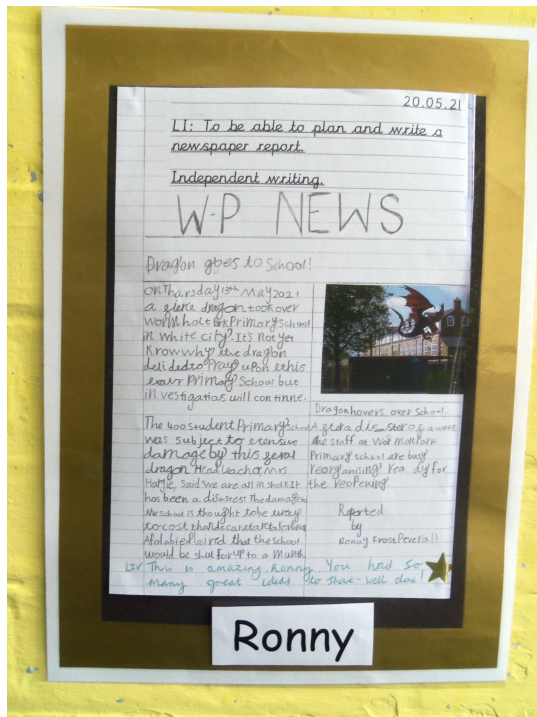
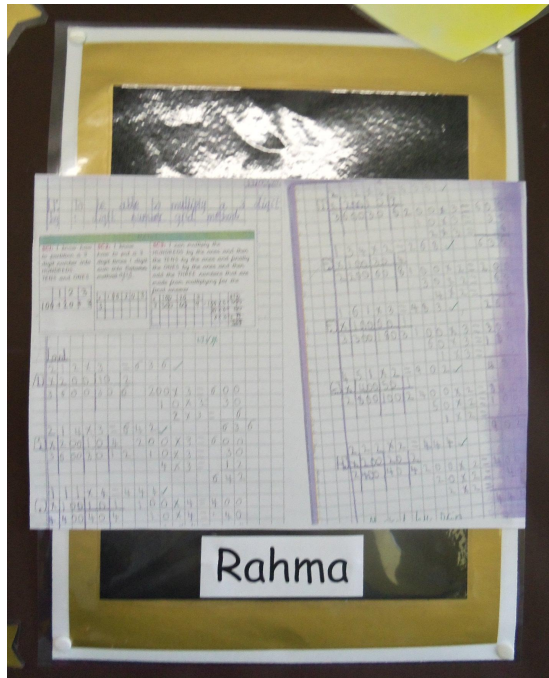
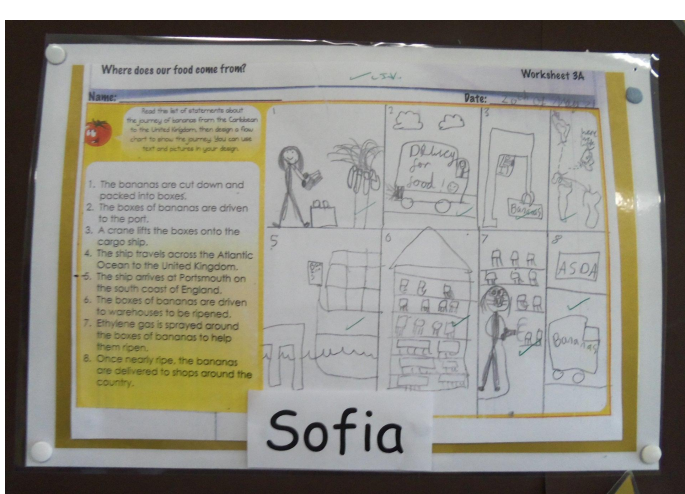
Wormholt Park's Hall of Fame



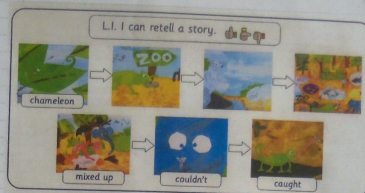
Look at the lovely pieces of work that the children have completed this week!

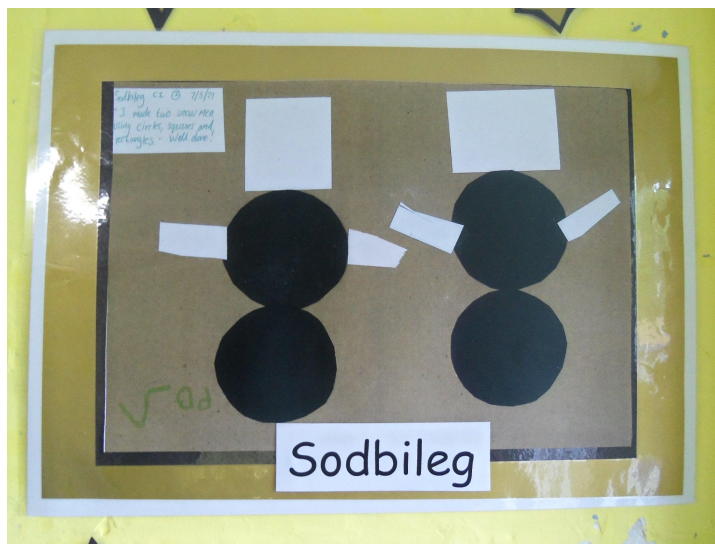
