



PSHCE underpins our whole school approach to learning and helping grow mature and resilient learners able to face the multiple challenges of modern life, including the virtual world.

Our PSHCE curriculum is shaped by the discrete delivery of SEAL (Social and Emotional Aspects of Learning) lessons supported by our whole school ethos which is in turn shaped and supported by our UNICEF Rights Respecting School Gold Level, our Equalities Award, our national and London Healthy School Gold Awards, TFL's STARS accreditation travel scheme, Young Citizens and our engagement with Skills Builder Partnership. We are also working towards developing further our current 'Supporter' status as a GenderAction school.

In Key Stages 1 and 2, SEAL lessons and Circle Time sessions are differently timetabled according to year group while in our Early Years Foundation Stage, PSED (Personal, Social and Emotional Development) is a daily focus.

All children also have the opportunity to engage with a number of extra-curricular opportunities that focus on PSHCE including special assemblies, RRS Top Table, workshops, our School Council with its UNICEF Rights Respecting Ambassadors and more.
