It's Friday again!

I have been really impressed this week, with how quickly the children have all adapted to their new classrooms, new friends and new teachers! Our new Reception and Nursery children have particularly impressed me, as many of them have never been to school before. They all deserve lots of hugs and congratulations.

COVID

As you know, COVID is still very much present and affecting those in our community. As I've explained before, the school no longer plays a role in identifying close contacts if there is a confirmed case. This role has now been fully assumed by NHS Track and Trace. If we have a confirmed case within the school, NHS Track and Trace will contact you directly and ask you to identify close contacts. NHS will then contact those identified and advise them to get a PCR or an LFD test. We very much want our school to remain open to all children and this will be achieved if we all work together, remain vigilant and alert the school if your child has any of the typical symptoms (A high temperature, a new continuous cough, a loss or change to sense of smell or taste, children often feel tired and have less energy.) If your child does display these symptoms we are advising that they take an LFD or a PCR test. We will be alerting parents to positive cases in your child's year group, so that we can all work together to keep everyone in our community safe.

Secondary Transfer - Year 6 Families

The Secondary School online application is open and the closing date is 31st October 2021.

All applications need to be made through your Local Authority, regardless of which borough your choice of school comes under. All applications need to be made online if possible. If you have to apply using a paper form, you will need to contact school admissions and request one. Unfortunately, they will not supply them to schools.

It is imperative applications are made on time, as late applications will not be processed until after the on-time applications have been dealt with and you may miss out on the school of your choice as a result. Please refer to the brochure for details of individual school tours and additional forms etc.

Jeff I hope you change for the better not the worse. Be a honest person no more. I know you can be the best person just show that you can! :)

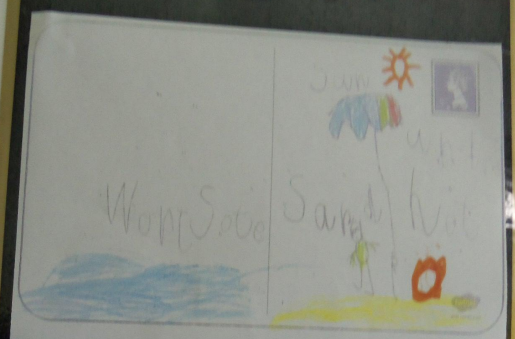
