Key Vocabulary	Definition
Transport	Take or carry (people or goods) from one place to another using a vehicle, ship or aircraft.
Air Transport	Transportation that flies in the air such as a plane or helicopter.
Land Transport	Land transport is the transport or movement of people, animals or goods from one location to another location on land.
Water Transport	Water transportation is the movement of transport on water.
Road Safety	Road traffic safety refers to the methods and measures used to prevent road users from being killed or seriously injured.
Engine	An engine is a machine with moving parts that converts power into motion.
Amelia Earhart	Earhart was the first female aviator to fly solo across the Atlantic Ocean.
Astronaut	An astronaut is a person trained to fly aboard a spacecraft
