Key Vocabulary	Definitions
Time line	A list of events in the order that they happened.
Historical Source	A historical source is something that originates from the past. Historians use these to help them to understand the past. These are things like photographs, artefacts and interviews.
Crimea War	A war between Great Britain, France, Turkey, and Sardinia on one side, and Russia on the other, fought chiefly in the Crimea 1853-56.
Nurse	A person who is trained to look after ill or injured people.
Lamp	A type of light.
Founder	A person who starts something.
Patient	Someone unwell or injures and needs to be looked after.
Soldier	Someone who serves in the army.
