Key Vocabulary	Definitions
<i>characteristic</i>	A trait of that person, e.g. kind, funny, hard-working, determined.
<i>hobby</i>	An interest. e.g. football or reading books.
<i>heritage</i>	The history of your family, e.g. country, culture, religion and language.
<i>beliefs</i>	An idea or religion you believe in.
<i>morals</i>	A standard of behaviour (understanding what is right or wrong).
<i>chronological</i>	Events in time order.
<i>local area study</i>	A geographical study of aspects of local physical or human geography.
<i>survey</i>	A general view, examination or description of someone or something.
<i>family tree</i>	A diagram showing the relationship between people in several generations of a family.
<i>human geography</i>	The branch of geography dealing with how human activity affects or is influenced by the Earth's surface.
<i>physical geography</i>	The branch of geography dealing with natural features.

Article 30: You have the right to enjoy your own culture, practise your own religion, and use your own language.

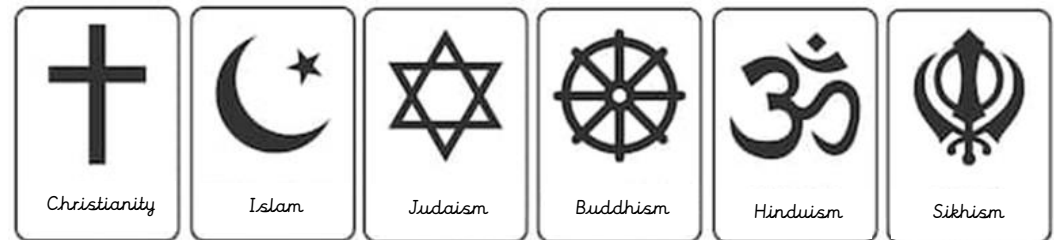
