

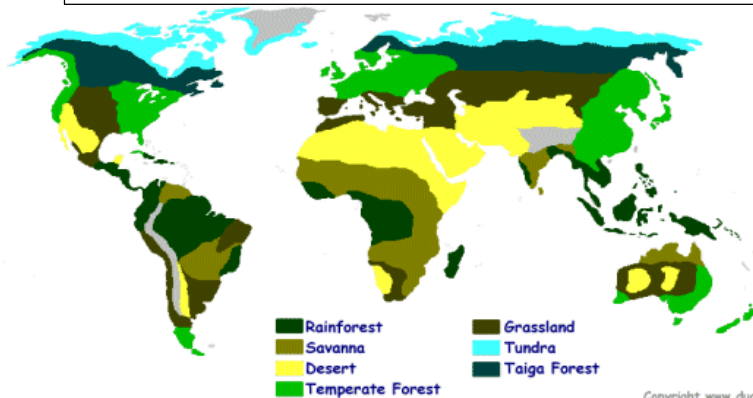

Key Vocabulary	Definitions
Trade links	The transfer of goods or services from one person or place to another.
Produce	Items made or manufactured from components or raw materials.
Distribution	Sharing something out among a number of recipients such as superstores.
Climate Zones	They are the divisions of the Earth's climates into zones according to the average temperatures and average rainfall.
Temperate climate	Environments with moderate rainfall spread across the year or portion of the year with sporadic drought, mild to warm summers and cool to cold winters.
Tropical climate	It is a damp climate in which all twelve months have mean temperatures above 18°C (64.4 °F). Tropical Climates have almost continuous rainfall throughout the year.
Mediterranean climate	It is a climate that has dry summers that are hot or warm as well as winters that are cool or mild with moderate or high rainfall.
Biome	A Biome is way to describe a large group of similar ecosystems. Biomes have similar weather, rainfall, animals, and plants. There are a number of biomes on planet Earth.
Deforestation	Deforestation is the clearing, or cutting down, of forests. The word is normally used to describe the actions of humans in removing forests from the planet, rather than destruction caused by such natural events as hurricanes.
