Topic:

The topic for this half term is People Who Help Us. We will be :

- thinking about workers in different roles, such as Fire Fighters and Postal Workers.
- we will also be reading the book The Jolly Postman
- visiting the local Post Office.

Literacy:



We will be learning about non-fiction writing.

The children will be learning to label parts of a fire engine or an ambulance as well as write captions for images.

The children will have the opportunity to write a class poem and perform it to their peers.

They will also learn new fact about emergency services and how they help us.

Phonics:



In Nursery, we are learning Phonic Phase 1.

This includes;

- Aural discrimination practice
- Listening to environmental sounds
- Beginning to learn Letter sound discrimination & learning letter names.
- Talking about story line, words, sounds, playing with sounds.

Maths:



This half term we will be focusing on:

- Shape (2D and 3D)
- Pattern
- Colour
- Numbers 1-10
- More than and less than
- Sequencing of events, (First, Then and after)

Physical Development (PD):



Our focus in PE this term is: **Body Management.**

Children will be able to:

- Explore balance and managing our own body including manipulating small objects.
- Able to stretch, reach and extend in a variety of ways and positions.
- Able to control body and perform specific movements on command

Understanding the World (UW):



This half term we will be learning about past and present events. We will be comparing how things have changed over time.

Science:

This term we will be focusing on investigative skills and science 'talk'. We will be thinking about scientific words and phrases.

Other Areas of Learning



Communication and Language:

Children will learn to improve their speaking skills, practising saying harder sounds and longer words. They will be using topic related vocabulary

Children will engage in both fiction and non-fiction books. Sharing learnt information during class activities supported by adults

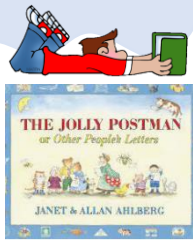
Home Learning:

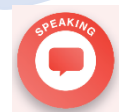
Poem of the Half Term:
