Topic: Anglo-Saxons and Vikings (Please see knowledge organiser for further information)



This half term we have a history focus. Children will be finding out about the Anglo-Saxons and explore the Viking invasions of Britain. Children will

- Learn how the Vikings settled in England and how this affected the Anglo Saxons.
- Describe some of the gods the Vikings worshipped.
- They will consider why the longship was a good mode of transport.
- Explore what life was like for Vikings living in Britain.

English:



Children will be using our Power of Reading book to write narratives based on characters and settings. We will be focusing on paragraph writing. Children will develop their comprehension skills through daily guided reading sessions when they will be answering retrieval, inference and word meaning questions linked to the chosen book.

The grammar concepts covered this half term include: active and passive voice, modal verbs, prefixes and suffixes.

Maths:



We will be covering the following topics this term:

- Multiplication and division
- Fractions
- Numbers - decimals and percentages

Every Tuesday, children will have an arithmetic focus for maths.

This half term, we will be learning about Properties of Material. Children will compare and group together everyday materials on the basis of their properties; understand some materials will dissolve in liquid to form a solution; describe how to recover a substance from a solution.
