#### Topic:

This half term our topic is Animals. We will be:

- Learning about different types of animals and their habitats
- The different parts of the world that animals live in
- Ordering the different stages of animals lives
- Creating a vets for children to role play with animals

#### Literacy:



We will be using our Power of Reading text: What the ladybird heard to help us think about print in books and in the environment. For example the first letter of our names, letters and words on a bus, a familiar logo or display words.

We will continue to take our books home on a Friday to share a story with our families. We will send home 'Wow' moment sheets so that you can share with us a drawing of things that you have seen or done at home or with your family at the weekend or after school

#### Phonics:



In Nursery, we are learning Phonic Phase 1.

This includes:

- Aural discrimination practice
- Listening to environmental sounds
- Beginning to learn Letter sound discrimination & learning letter names.
- Talking about story line, words, sounds, playing with sounds.

#### Maths:



This half term we will be focusing on:  
**One more and one less**

The children will use real objects to see that the quantity of a group can be changed by adding more.

The children will also be looking at pattern and recreating patterns of what comes next.

At home you might like to encourage your child to see the link between counting forwards and the one more pattern and back and the one less pattern.

#### Physical Development (PD):



Our focus in PE this term is: **MOVEMENT**

Children will be able to:

Gross motor skills: Move their bodies in different ways to copy the different ways that animals move, such as crawling and slithering.

Focus on balancing on different parts of our bodies, such as one leg.

Fine motor skills: Use a range of small tools, including pencils, scissors, rulers and cutlery.

## Understanding the World (UW):



This half term we will be learning about

### Science:

This term we will be learning about different animals. Children will be able to sort and clarify them into groups.

## Other Areas of Learning



### Communication and Language:

Children will be able to;

Offer explanations for why things might happen such as predictions of what might happen next in a book or how a plant might develop. Express their feelings about their experiences, using full sentences, including use of past, present and future tenses. For example, they will be encouraged to describe what they did at the weekend and what they plan to do the following weekend.

We encourage our parents to read to their child for at least 15 minutes every day.

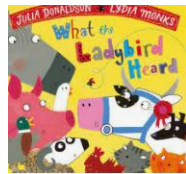
We will give you a storybook to read to your child each week.
