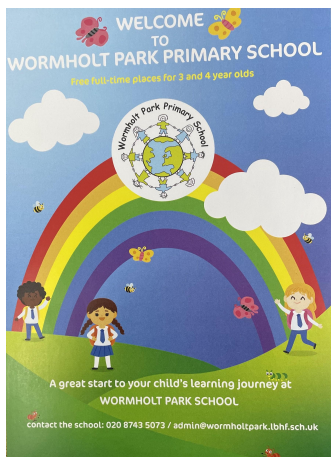

Parents and carers of children currently in Year 5 (who will be going into Year 6 in the next academic year), You are invited to attend the *Transferring to Secondary School* meeting being held on **Wednesday 14th September from 9.00 to 10.00am** in our bottom hall. Sam Lord is the Transition Coordinator provided by the Local Authority to support you and your children with choice and advice sessions regarding Secondary School options in Hammersmith and Fulham.

The Session on **Wednesday 14th September 2022** will guide you through :

- what the different type of Secondary School options are;
- how to understand the school's admissions criteria;
- what banding tests will mean to parents and their children;
- what specialist (aptitude) places are available in certain schools;
- what foundation (SIF) places will mean for you and your child;
- the process of how to apply online;
- why it is important to choose your six places, as well as timelines and open days of visits to Secondary Schools.

There will be a Q&A at the end to address any further queries or concerns.

We are pleased to announce that we have two more Class Assemblies scheduled for this term:

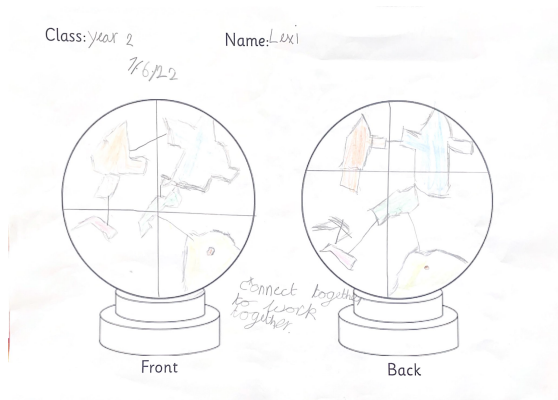
- Friday 1st July: Year 4 - Athens Class

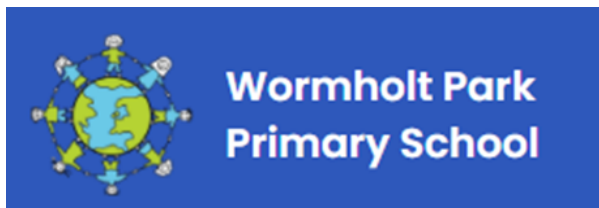
