Topic:

This half term our topic is Journeys. We will be:

- Discussing the different ways we can travel, including road safety
- Reading and creating maps of the local area
- Looking at how different types of transport work and where we use them

Literacy:



We will be using our Power of Reading text: **Naughty Bus** to help support our understanding of books and how we use them. This will help us to develop our understanding that print holds meaning and that print can have different purposes.

We will continue to take our books home on a Friday to share a story with our families. We will send home 'Wow' moment sheets so that you can share with us a drawing of things that you have seen or done at home or with your family at the weekend or after school.

Phonics:



In Nursery, we are learning Phonic Phase 1.

This includes;

- Aural discrimination practice
- Listening to environmental sounds
- Beginning to learn Letter sound discrimination & learning letter names.
- Talking about story line, words, sounds, playing with sounds.

Maths:



This half term we will be focusing on: capacity, positional language and sequencing.

Describing a sequence of events, focusing on our daily routines and building our vocabulary such as: day, night, morning, afternoon, before after, today and tomorrow.

Exploring capacity including building on our understanding of full and empty.

Discussing positional language such as: *in, on, under up, down, and across.*

Physical Development (PD):



Our focus in PE this term is: Keeping our bodies healthy.

Children will be able to: Talk about how to keep our bodies healthy through exercise.

We will continue to move in a range of ways to keep our bodies healthy.

Understanding the World (UW):



This half term we will be learning about floating and sinking.

Science:

This term we will be exploring how different objects can float and sink. We will link this to different modes of transport.

Other Areas of Learning



Communication and Language:

Children will discuss the different ways we can travel using our bodies.

Talk about where we would want to travel by train.

Repeat words and phrases from familiar stories including our Power of Reading book Naughty Bus.

Home Learning:



We encourage our parents to read to their child for at least 15 minutes every day. We will give you a storybook to read to your child each week. Please return this book to be changed on Fridays.

Our Power of reading book this term is Naughty Bus



Language of the Half Term:



Our language of the half term is Bengali and Turkish (1.9%) of families in our school community speak Bengali or Turkish
