Topic

The topic this term is Water. The children will be learning about the different forms of water, as well as why water is so important to us. We will also be looking at pollution in our waters and how to keep them clean.

Literacy



We will be learning to:

- Make posters on how to keep our waters clean
- Looking at different posters to see what features they have
- Write list of things we can do to look after our planet
- Writing facts about sea life animals and plants
- Sequencing the life cycle of sea life animals

Phonics



By the end of Phase 4 children should be able to read 14 more Tricky words.

Some, come, one, said, do, when, have, there, out, like, so, were, little, what.

They should now also be able to spell the tricky words from phase 2 and 3. (the, to, I, no, go, he, she, we, me, be, was, my, you, her, they, all, are)

CCVC Words

The word 'crab' is a CCVC word (consonant / consonant / vowel / consonant). Other CCVC words include: trim, flat & step.

CVCC Words

The word 'help' is a CVCC word (consonant / vowel / consonant / consonant). Other CVCC words include: fist, mend and test.

This half term children will be working on:

Expressive Art and Design:

This term the children will be using the knowledge they have acquired throughout the year to explain the processes they have used. They will also be performing songs, rhymes and poems with others.

Home Learning

Children should read for 15 minutes every night. They will be given two books each week. One is a reading for pleasure book, this should be read together. The other book is a phonetically decodable-banded book for your child to read to you.
