This half term we are continuing our geography focus. We will be learning about America. Children will be:

- Locate the USA and identify and compare its states
- Identify and compare natural phenomena
- Plan a visit to America

English:



We will be studying non chronological reports this half term. Children will be writing a report about the Animals found in the Lion the Unicorn and Other Hairy Tales.

Children will continue to develop their comprehension skills through daily guided reading sessions where they be looking at prediction skills and summarising main ideas.
