Topic: South America

This half term we have a geography focus. Children will be learning about South America. Children will

- Learn about trade and industry in South America

- Explain how rivers are important to a human environment
- Compare an area of South America (Brazil) with the UK.
- Carry out an in depth study of a South American country.

English:

Children will develop their writing skills through using narrative voice, passive and active choices, rhetorical questions and metaphor and imagery.

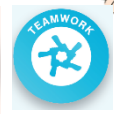
