This half term, we have a geography focus. We will be conducting a project called, "Me, myself and I". Children will learn to:

- Create a timeline to show key events in their lifetime
- Use maps to identify longitude and latitude. Study maps to identify and compare environmental regions
- Complete a local area investigation.

English:



This half term we will be using our existing skills and knowledge to create new pieces of writing. We will also be working on our editing skills to improve existing pieces and prepare for secondary school

Maths:



This half term we will be continuing to practise all our maths knowledge and skills to prepare for secondary school.

This half term, we will be studying the theory of evolution. Children will learn:

- Recognise that living things have changed over time and that fossils provide information about living things that inhabited the Earth millions of years ago.
- Recognise that living things produce offspring of the same kind, but normally offspring vary and are not identical to their parents.
- Identify how animals and plants are adapted to suit their environment in different ways and that adaptation may lead to evolution.

Art/DT: We will be combining 2D and 3D art to create a mini museum

Music: We will be studying Music and Me - a Lyric composition.

PE:




PE is on Wednesday afternoon and Friday morning (when children are not in the Art Studio). Children should bring their PE kits into school to get changed.
