# **Our School Development Plan (SDP)**

Every year, as a school, we think carefully about what we need to do in order to be even better. We then create a School Development Plan (SDP) which outlines the priorities for the year.

This year our priorities are as follows:

• To develop the Wider Curriculum across the school

We have bought curriculums for Geography, History, Computing, French, PSHE, Art & Design, Design & Technology and Music. The curriculums have been produced by a company called Kapow. The planning ensures that teachers can identify the key knowledge that they want the children to learn and ensure that it is well sequenced. This will enable the children to know and remember more over time. The feedback from staff and children has been extremely positive so far. Please ask your child what they have been learning in these subjects, as this will help them to remember.

• To improve writing across the school

All the teachers have received training in how to support children with their writing. As a school, we are creating a new writing scheme of work, which will enable the children to make rapid progress.

• To improve children's memories

We are constantly recapping on and revisiting learning to enable children to consolidate their learning and remember more. We are actively encouraging parents/carers to talk to their children regularly to enable them to recall knowledge they have learnt at school.

• To develop subject leaders

We now have subject leaders for every subject. The leaders will have lots of training to make them the best leaders they can be. This will enable them to lead their subjects successfully and monitor the teaching and learning in their subject to ensure good progress is made across the school.

• To develop the new Early Years Curriculum

All staff have received training on the new curriculum. We are increasing opportunities for sensory play. We are building stronger relationships between home and school.




