Year 6 went to the Lyric to watch a pantomime. They were all very excited and said it was BRILLIANT!



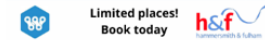

Reception Harvest

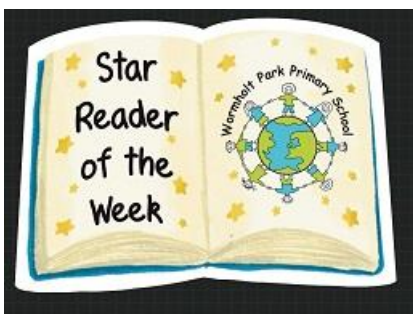
Reception harvested some carrots from their garden in their playground. The children loved being able to see where the carrots came from and eat them on the same day!
