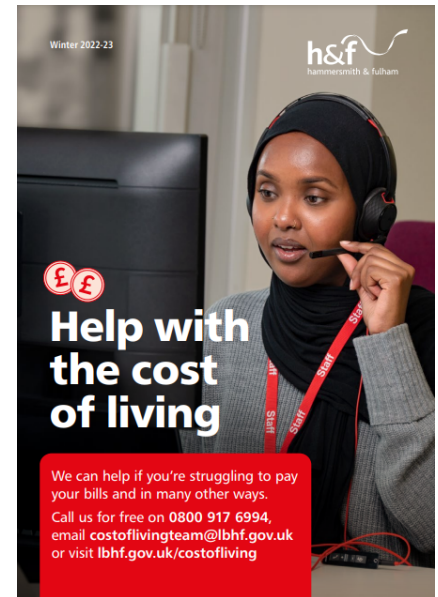

- Friday 3rd February 2023 - Tripoli (Year 5)

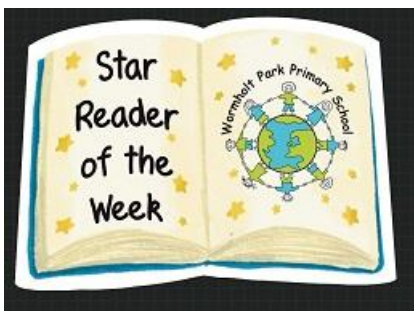
