Spring Spectacular free activities and food

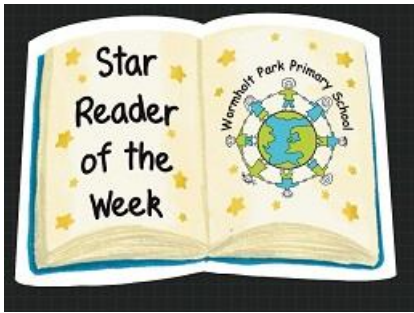
Following on from Hammersmith & Fulham's hugely successful February Half-Term Programme, they are now getting ready for some fun throughout the Easter Holiday.
