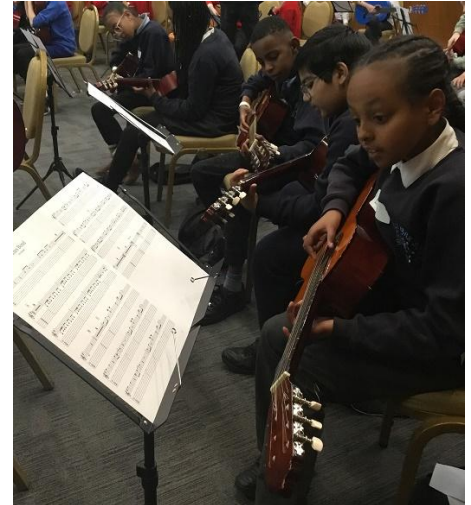

# Inspire Coffee Mornings

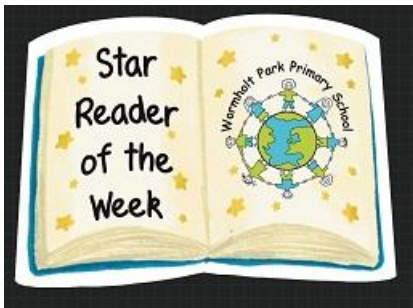
