Our Sports Day will be held in June this year.

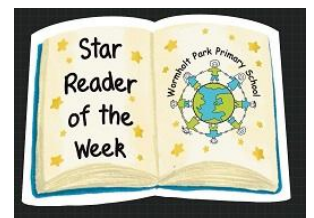
- Early Years and Key Stage 1 will be on **Wednesday 7th June** in Wormholt Park from 9.30am
