Class assemblies being held in the Summer term are:

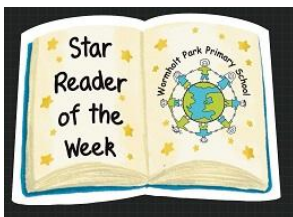
- Friday 19th May 2023 - Harare (Year 1)
