Ready, Set, Read!

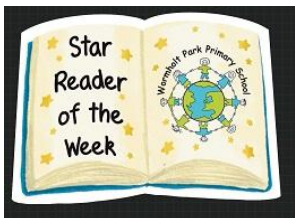
