Please join us on Wednesday 13th December for our Parent Party in the bottom hall! It will be from 2.00pm until home-time!






### **Foodbank Donations**

Please make sure your child brings a water bottle to school daily. The indoor fountains will of course still be functioning.


# Stay and Play - Toddlers and Babies

### **Weekly Book Review**


This week we have a book review from Ottawa Class (Reception)


"I love Wonky Donkey because it is funny." Alp

# Skills Builder Weekly Challenge

Have you been completing any of these skills builder challenges at home? Please let us know how you are finding these. Here is this week's challenge!

Make a protective holder for an egg that would stop the egg from cracking if it was dropped from 2 metres high. Your aim is to generate an idea that fits this brief: do not break the egg!

Think about what materials you could use, think about if the materials are strong enough to hold the egg, think about how you could stop the egg from falling out of the holder.

Extension: Once you have tested the egg holder, write down how you would improve it for next time
