Physical Development (PD)

Our focus in PE this term is: **Body Management**. Children will be able to:

- Able to control body and perform specific movements on command

We will be using various materials to build and create different types of transports. Junk modelling, Lego and other construction materials will be our primary resources. Children will learn to plan their creation by drawing them first.

Home Learning

Every Monday's your child will receive a Google Classroom activity they can complete online. Home learning is handed out at the beginning of each term with a weekly breakdown with what we cover.
