

Humanities: History

This half term we have a history focus. We will be learning about how hard it was to invade and settle in Britain. Children will be able to:

- Name key features of Anglo Saxon settlements
- Explain the threat posed by the Vikings
- Identify changes and continuities in settlements from prehistoric Britain

English:

We will be studying diary entries and shape poetry the children will be writing from perspective of the wild robot.

Children will develop their comprehension skills through daily guided reading sessions where they be looking at retrieval questions, prediction and the meaning behind a word

The grammar concepts covered this half term will be adverbs, adverbials and conjunctions. Children will also attempt to extend simple, and complex sentences.

Science:



This half term we will have a chemistry focus and will be studying states of matter. Children will learn to

- Identify solids, liquids and gases using their properties.
- Describe melting, freezing, condensing and evaporating.
- Describe the different stages of the water cycle.
- Describe how temperature affects the rate of evaporation and therefore the water cycle.

Maths:

We will be covering the following topics this term:

- Timetables up to 2-12
- Place Value (Recap from Autumn Term)
- Multiply and divide 2 and 3 digit numbers by 1 digit numbers
- Unit and Non- unit fractions
- Equivalent Fractions
- Add and Subtract Fractions
- Computing: Website Design



This half term we will be looking at Website Design. The children will be able to:

- Use a variety of different slide styles to convey information including images and transitions
- Being thoughtful on a collaborative document
