#### History: Explorers



This half term, we have a History focus. We will be learning about explorers. Children will:

- Explain what explorers do
- Name equipment or transport an explorer would need.
- Name important explorers.

#### English:



We will be learning to...

- To recap conjunctions, suffixes, prefixes, capital letters and full stops.
- To explore and develop ideas through talk and to listen to each other's responses.
- To develop creative responses to the text through drama, play and artwork.
- To write in role in order to explore characters and events.

#### Maths:



We will be covering the following topics this half term:

- To recap counting in multiples of 2s, 5s, 10s
- To use grouping in calculations
- To use sharing in calculations
- Multiplication
- Division
- Fractions

#### Science:



This half term, we will be learning about Plants. We will

- Identify plants and their features.
- Recall some of the roles that flowering plant parts have.
- Name some trees and their parts.
- Identify similarities and differences between deciduous and evergreen leaves.
- Recall that seeds and bulbs come from plants.

Spellings for the week are posted on Google Classroom every Tuesday and are in your child's reading record.

### Reading:

Children should practise reading for at least 15 minutes every day.

This term year 1 are learning our x2, x5 and x10 times table

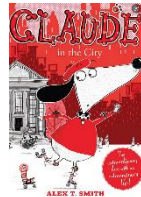
- 1)  $1 \times 2 = 2$
- 2)  $2 \times 2 = 4$
- 3)  $3 \times 2 = 6$
- 4)  $4 \times 2 = 8$
- 5)  $5 \times 2 = 10$
- 6)  $6 \times 2 = 12$
- 7)  $7 \times 2 = 14$
- 8)  $8 \times 2 = 16$
- 9)  $9 \times 2 = 18$
- 10)  $10 \times 2 = 20$
- 11)  $11 \times 2 = 22$

Children should practise their 2, 5 and 10 times table every day
