








History:



This term our topic focus is History. We will be exploring the question 'What is a Monarch?' We will be

- Learning that a monarch is a king or queen who is crowned in a ceremony called a coronation
- Learning about a monarch from the past and comparing their role with modern monarchs
- Identify features of Norman castles and explore how they have changed over time

English:





In English this term we will be looking at Non-Fiction Texts.

We will be exploring the features found in non-fiction texts and writing our own non-chronological reports.

We will be covering the following topics in maths this half term:

- Measurement: Length and height
- Geometry: Position and direction
- Calculation: Multiplication, division, subtraction and addition

Our science topic this half term is Plants. The children will:

- Observe and describe how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants.
- Find out and describe how plants need water, light and a suitable temperature to grow and stay healthy.

Children should practise reading for at least 15 minutes every day. Books are changed on **Tuesdays**.
