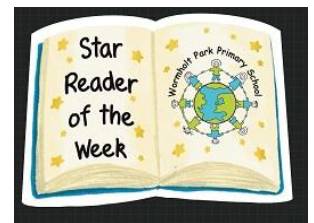

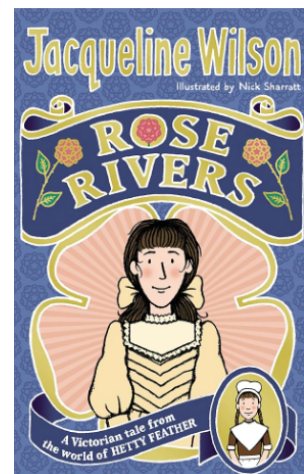
Weekly Book Review


