- what specialist (aptitude) places are available in certain schools;

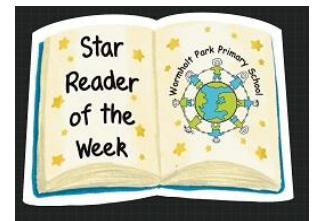
- what foundation (SIF) places will mean for you and your child;

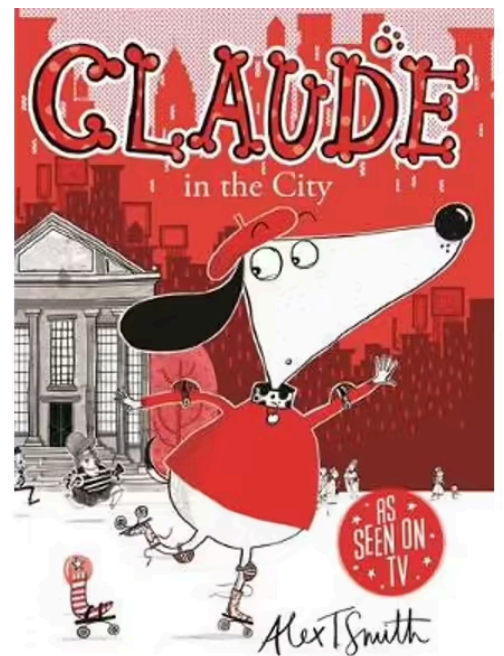
## Weekly Book Review

**Intermediate:** Why is it important to be willing to take on new challenges?



