Topic: Where do animals live

This half term our topic is 'Where do animals live'. We will be:

- Learning about the habitats of different animals, fostering respect and care for the environment and living beings.
- Identifying different habitats and the animals that live in them.
- Recognizing the basic characteristics of each habitat.

to share a story with our families. We will send home

'Wow' moment sheets so that you can share with us a

drawing of things that you have seen or done at home

or with your family at the weekend or after school.

Literacy:



Phonics:



In Nursery, we are learning Phonic Phase 1.

This includes:

- Aural discrimination practice
- Listening to environmental sounds
- Beginning to learn Letter sound discrimination & learning letter names.
- Talking about story line, words, sounds, playing with sounds.

Maths:



This half term we will be focusing on: capacity, positional language and sequencing.

Describing a sequence of events, focusing on our daily routines and building our vocabulary such as: day, night, morning, afternoon, before after, today and tomorrow.

Exploring capacity including building on our understanding of full and empty.

Discussing positional language such as: in, on, under up, down, and across.

Physical Development (PD):



Our focus in PE this term is: Keeping our bodies healthy.

Children will be able to: Talk about how to keep our bodies healthy through exercise.

We will continue to move in a range of ways to keep our bodies healthy.

Understanding the World (UW):



This half term we will be learning about floating and sinking.

Science:

This term we will be exploring how different objects can float and sink.

Other Areas of Learning



Communication and Language:

Children will discuss different animals and where they live

Talk about how we take care of the environment.


Repeat words and phrases from familiar stories including from our core text Yucky Worms.


