Humanities: Geography



This half term we have a geography focus. Children will be learning about the desert. Children will

- Identify the lines of latitude where hot desert biomes are located.
- Describe the characteristics of a hot desert biome.
- Locate the largest deserts in each continent.
- Describe ways the Mojave Desert is used.
- Name and describe the physical features found in a desert.
- Identify how humans use the desert.

English:



Children will be using our Core Reading book to write a newspaper report.

Children will develop their writing skills through using a variety of skills.

Children will also develop their reading skills through VIPERS.

Maths:



We will be covering the following topics this half term:

- Properties of Shape
- Position and direction
- Converting Units
- Volume

Every Wednesday, children will have an arithmetic/ Reasoning focus for maths.

Science:



This half term, we will be learning about Animals and the human timeline. Studying human development and changes, children identify key stages and consider what data may help determine if a child is growing normally. They describe how puberty affects girls and boys and produce graphs to compare how gestation periods vary across different mammals, including humans.

Computing:



Digital Literacy: Internet Safety

Pupils will be learning:

- Dash Robots

Art/DT: DT focus - Which foods are healthier?

Music: We will be looking at the composition notation and the theme will be Ancient Egypt.

RSHE: We will be learning about Safety and the changing body.

RE: We will be learning about Pilgrimage across different religions such as Christianity, Humanism and Hinduism

French: We will be looking at the unit "Meet my French family"

PE:



PE is on Tuesday afternoon and Wednesday Afternoon. This half term, we will be focusing on athletics and rounders. Children can come to school in their PE kits.

Spellings:



Children will have a spelling test every Monday.

Children will receive their practice sheets for their spellings after their spelling tests on Monday.

Children should learn their spellings each week using: Look, Say, Cover, Write and Check

Reading:

Children should read for at least 15 minutes every day.

Times Tables:



Children should practice their timetables every day.

They will have a timetables test every Monday.

Children will be tested on a mix of times tables every week in a timed test.

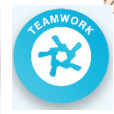
