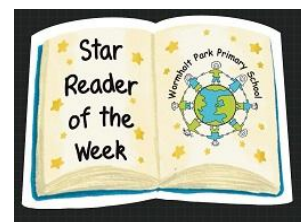
Our class loved this book, as it had such a wide variety of different poems and short stories. It was very entertaining . We have never read a book like this before. We would give this book 5 stars!
