Reading: Children should practise reading for at least 15 minutes every day. Reading records should be signed and returned every <u>Tuesday.</u>

Times Tables:



Children in KS1 will be expected to be able to count in steps of 2s, 5s and 10s.

By the end of KS1 your child will begin to link counting in steps to times tables.
