History:

This half term, we have a History focus. We will be learning about the Tudors. Children will research and lea about what life was like in the Tudor times. Children will also learn about the significant people from the Tudor times and some key vocabulary that will support their learning in History. Children will:

- Extract information about significant people from the Tudor times
- Use a variety of sources to gain information and find evidence to make deductions about what life was like in the Tudor times.

English:

We will be studying character descriptions and persuasive writing.

Children will be using our Reading book, 'There's a Boy in the Girls Bathroom' to write a character description and persuasive letters. Children will develop their comprehension skills through daily guided reading sessions where they will be answering vocabulary, inference, prediction, explain, retrieval and summarise style questions linked to the chosen

Every <u>Tuesday</u>, children will have an arithmetic focus for maths.

Science:

This half term, we will be learning about materials including mixtures and separation. Children will develop these skills through a series of lessons and experiments.

Children will be learning how to programme music.

French: We will be learning about Monster pets.

Our core reading text this half term is There's a Boy in the Girl's Bathroom by Louis Sachar


