Thank you all so much for your continued support. We love working with our families to ensure the


children have the best possible time at school. Please remember that you can always come and chat to me and other members of the SLT in the playground before and after school.


Your child will qualify for the HAF programme if all these statements apply to you:

This week, the Star Readers of the Week are Chloe from Lima Class (Y2) and Erin from Tripoli Class (Y5). Well Done both of you!




Weekly Book Review
