Geography



This term our humanities focus is Geography. We will be finding answers to the question 'Why are Rainforests important to us? Children will:

- Locate and identify the Amazon Rainforest using an atlas
- Explore the four layers of the Rainforests and the biome in which it resides.

English:



We will be learning about Narrative:

The children will be looking at the structure, purpose and audience of a narrative.

Our grammar focus for this half term is:

- Imperative verbs
- Adverbs

Maths:



We will be covering the following topics this half term:

- Measurement (Conversion)
- Measurement (Perimeter)
- Multiplication
- Division
- Timetables

Science:



Our science topic this half term is Electricity and Circuits will:

- Recall a range of electrical appliances and classify them as mains or battery-powered.
- Explain why something is either mains or battery-powered.
- Explain how to test if a circuit works and identify when simple electric circuits will work.

Computing:



Computer Science: Further Coding with Scratch
Children will:

- Understand how to create a simple script in Scratch - be able to change sprite and prevent the sprite from rotating.

Art/DT: We will be looking at Paints and Mixed Media

Music: We will be looking at Body and Tuned Percussion with the theme of Rainforests

RHE: We will be looking at families and relationships

RE: We will be looking at worship
