



Topic: People who help us




- Police/firefighters: We will learn about police officers and firefighters, and what they do to help society.
 - School Caretaker. We will meet the school caretaker so we can ask him about what he does to help in our school.
 - Teachers. Our school is full of teachers! This means we can ask them all lots of questions about their jobs!

Literacy:

We will be reading these books:

- The Jolly Postman by Allan Ahlberg
- Emergency Services Emergency! by Margaret Mayo
- Dentist Going to the Dentist Read-Aloud by Anne Civardig"







Phonics:



In Nursery, we are continuing to learn Phonic Phase 1. We are also starting to look at initial sounds in words. E.g. 'W' for 'Water'.

This includes;

- Aural discrimination practice
- Listening to environmental sounds
- Beginning to learn Letter sound discrimination & learning letter names.
- Talking about story line, words, sounds, playing with sounds.

Maths:



This half term we will be focusing on: Fast recognition of up to 3/4 objects without having to count them individually - which we call **Subitising**.

Children will:

- Show finger numbers up to 4
- Sing number songs with the number 4.
- Continuing our learning about weight, expanding to length, size and height.

Physical Development (PD):



Gross motor skills:

Work with others to manage large items, such as moving a long plank safely.

Increasingly able to move to music and rhythm. Fine motor skills:

Showing a preference for a dominant hand when mark-making.

Focusing on independence in getting dressed. Attempting buttons on coats, zips and putting fingered gloves on.

Understanding the World (UW): 3



This half term we will be learning about:

Collections of materials with similar and/or different properties.

Different occupations.

Explore and talk about different forces they can feel.

Talk about the differences between materials and changes they notice.

Other Areas of Learning



Communication and Language:

Children will be able to:

Use a wider range of vocabulary.

Begin to understand and respond to 'why' questions.

Know many rhymes, be able to talk about familiar books, and be able to tell a long story.

Enjoy listening to longer stories and can remember much of what happens.

Home Learning:

We will give you a storybook to read to your child every week. Please read every day with your child for 15 minutes. Make it a special, cosy time you both enjoy and have fun with. Please return books to be changed on Fridays. You can start to count up to 5, 10 and 20 if you are enjoying numbers at home!
