



Geography: Antarctica



This half term we have a Geography focus. We will be learning about the Antarctica. Children will:

- Understand the position and significance of lines of latitude.
- Describe the location, physical and human features of Antarctica.
- Be able to use four-figure grid references to plot Shackleton's route to Antarctica.
- Plan a simple route on a map using compass points.

English:





We will be studying how to write a newspaper report using the book: Pugs of the Frozen North by Philip Reeve and Sarah McIntyre. We will be learning how to write in first person. Children will develop their comprehension skills through daily guided reading sessions, where they will be completing a series of activities based of VIPERS (Vocabulary, infer, predict, explain, retrieve and summarise) The grammar concepts we will be focusing on this half term include: nouns, verbs, adjectives, adverbs and conjunctions.

Science:



This half-term, we will be learning about Light and Shadows. Children will understand the difference between light and dark. Learn about a light source giving out light and that it is also known as luminous. Bright lights can damage eyes and all surfaces reflect at least a little light where light bounces off them. Shadows form when a slight source is blocked out.

Language of the Half Term:




Our language of the half term is Albanian. Our Albanian community represents 2.8% of our families.
