Geography: Why do oceans matter?

This half term we have a Geography focus. Children will be finding out about why the ocean is important to us and explore the different reasons they matter. Children will

- Describe how the ocean is used for human activity.
- Explain how the ocean helps to regulate the Earth's climate and temperature.
- Identify the Great Barrier Reef as part of Australia.
- Describe the benefits of the Great Barrier Reef.
- Describe how humans impact the oceans and the consequences of this.

English:

Children will be using our core text book, Varmints We will write a play script and a setting description.
Children will develop their comprehension skills using VIPERS through daily guided reading sessions.

The grammar concepts covered this half term include: active and passive voice, modal verbs, prefixes and suffixes. Children will also practise using commas, hyphens, brackets, dashes, semi-colons, colons or dashes and parentheses.

Maths:



We will be covering the following topics this term:

- Multiplication and division
- Fractions
- Numbers decimals and percentages

Science:

This half term, we will be learning about living things.
Children will have a focus on life cycles and
reproductions. Children will use a variety of enquiry
types to research and learn about living things.

Computing:

Children will be working on search engines. Children w

- Explain what a search engine is, suggesting several search engines to use and explain how to use them to find websites and information.
- Suggest that things online aren't always true and recognise what to check for.
- Explain why keywords are important and what TASK stands for, using these strategies to search effectively.
