History:



This term our topic focus is History. We will be looking at important events surrounding the history of flight. We will be...

- Learning about historical significant people and their achievements.

- Identify inventions that still influence our lives today.

English:



In English this term we will be exploring postcard and poetry writing.

Maths:

PE:

Spellings:



Children should learn their spellings each week using: Look, Say Cover, Write Check

Children will have a spelling test every Monday

Spellings for the Summer term are posted on Google Classroom and are on your child's Home Learning sheet given out every Tuesday.

Reading:

Children should practise reading for at least 15 minutes every day. Books are changed on **Tuesdays**.

Times Tables:



Children in KS1 will be expected to be able to count in steps of 2s, 5s and 10s. Each Monday we will have a times tables test to improve our fluency and recall. Question will be chosen from the 2x, 5x and 10x tables.
