Friday 13th June Head's Chat

Dear Families,

I am writing to you with a heavy heart regarding a change we are having to make in how we run our after-school clubs.

As many of you will have seen in the news, schools across the country are facing significant and ongoing funding challenges. Unfortunately, our school is no exception. Despite our best efforts to absorb rising costs and avoid passing them on to families, we are now in a position where we can no longer continue offering after-school clubs for free.

From the Autumn term, we will need to begin charging a fee of £3.50 per session for all after-school clubs. I know this is disappointing news, and I want to assure you that this decision was not made lightly. We have managed to avoid this step for the past few years, but the current financial pressures have left us with no alternative.

Most schools already charge for their clubs, and we have done everything possible to delay joining them. Our aim is still to keep our provision accessible and affordable for all families, and we will continue to explore ways to keep this cost as low as possible.

I am genuinely very sorry that we've had to take this step. Our school community is incredibly important to us, and we remain committed to providing a safe, enriching environment for your children.

Thank you for your understanding and continued support. Have a lovely weekend.


Weekly Book Review
