Humanities: Geography

This half term, we will be carrying out a local fieldwork enquiry. Children will learn to:

- Give examples of issues in the local area.
- Identify questions to be asked to find relevant data.
- Justify which data method is most suitable.



This half term we will be using our existing skills and knowledge to create new pieces of writing. We will also be working on our editing skills to improve existing pieces and prepare for secondary school.

Science:

This half term, we will be studying the theory of evolution. Children will learn:

- Recognise that living things have changed over time and that fossils provide information about living things that inhabited the Earth millions of years ago.
- Recognise that living things produce offspring of the same kind, but normally offspring vary and are not identical to their parents.
- Identify how animals and plants are adapted to suit their environment in different ways and that adaptation may lead to evolution.

Maths:

This half term we will be working on some practical White Rose Maths problems with real-life applications, and we will continue to practise all our maths knowledge and skills to prepare for secondary school.

Computing:

Digital Literacy: Skill showcase - Designing a product

- Pupils will evaluate code and adapt it to a specific purpose.
- Pupils will debug programmes and make them more efficient.
- Pupils will create an appealing website for their product.

Art/DT: We will be starting a DT project called, "Navigating the world."

Music: We will be composing and performing a Leaver's song.

RSHE: We will be learning about safety and the changing body.

RE: We will be looking at ideas around Sewa.

French: We will be asking for and giving directions.

PE is on <u>Tuesday afternoon</u> and Wednesay <u>afternoon</u>. Children should bring their PE kits into school to get changed.




