

- what the different type of Secondary School options are
- how to understand the school's admissions criteria
- what banding tests will mean to parents and their children
- what specialist (aptitude) places are available in certain schools;
- what foundation (SIF) places will mean for you and your child;

- the process of how to apply online;
- why it is important to choose your six places, as well as timelines and open days of visits to Secondary Schools


