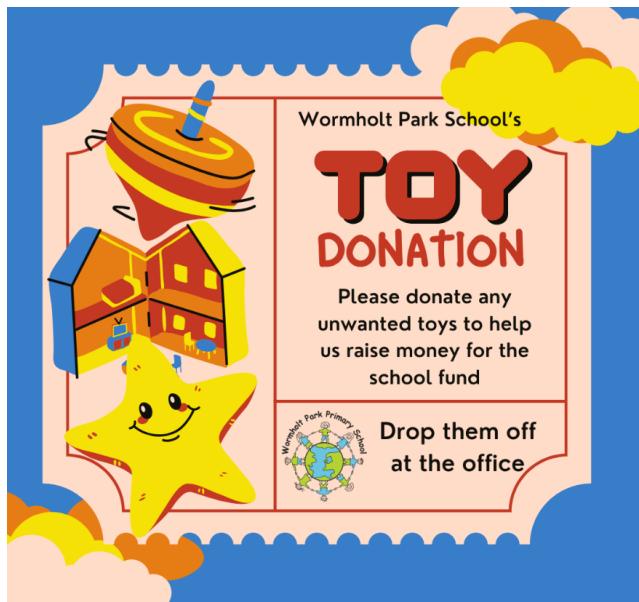
Opal Playground - Stay & Play!

Sam Lord will support you and your child with choice and advice sessions regarding Secondary School options in Hammersmith and Fulham. The Session on Wednesday 10th September 2025 will guide you through :

- what the different type of Secondary School options are;

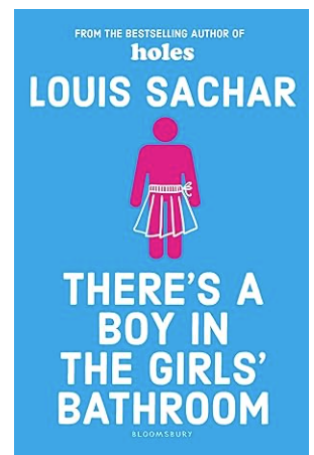

This week we have a book review from Tripoli Class (Y5)

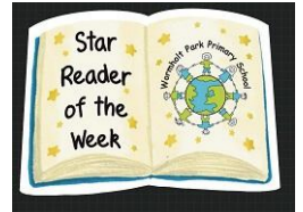
Book Review: **There is a Boy in the Girls Bathroom** by Louis Sachar
