Confident Parent Happy Child is an organisation that offers parenting programmes in Hammersmith and Fulham – designed to help aid and enhance parent child relationships, they would like to share their Autumn term programme . Programme can be found by [clicking here](#). Details below of groups starting in September:

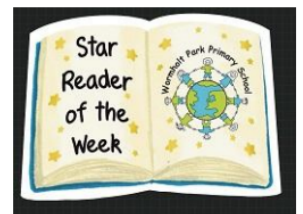
1. Strengthening Families Strengthening Communities a 13-week programme that supports parents and carers of children aged 3–18. Parents learn a range of practical skills and insights that directly support their child's behaviour both at home and in school.
2. Teen Triple P a 5-week programme that empowers parents with practical tools to support their teens through the most challenging years. Parents learn a range of practical strategies that directly support their teenager's emotional wellbeing, behaviour and development.
3. Parent-led Child anxiety group a 6-week programme for parents/carers primary age children struggling with anxiety. The programme, delivered by Community CAMHS team, explores the early signs of anxiety and strategies to help support young people to overcome them.
4. Triple P a 6-week programme for parents/carers of children up to 12 years old. Focuses on strengthening parent-child relationships, encouraging positive and managing challenging behaviour.
