Humanities:



This half term, we have a History focus. We will be learning about how we are making history. Children will:

- Order photographs correctly on a simple timeline.
- Use the terms 'before' and 'after' when discussing their timelines.
- Talk about memories and place one of them on a timeline.

English:



This half term in Year 1, we'll be focusing on name writing and labelling activities to help build your child's confidence with early writing skills. Children will practise writing their full name with correct letter formation and begin to label pictures using simple words and sounds they've learned in phonics.

Maths:



We will be covering the following topics this half term:

- Place value
(Numbers within 10)
- Addition and Subtraction (within 10)
- Geometry (Shape)

Science:



This half term, we will be learning about the Seasons, how they change and different weather conditions. The children will explore the different activities and celebrations for each season.

Computing:



Digital Literacy: *Internet Safety*

- Pupils will know that to stay safe online it is important to keep personal information safe.

Computer Science: *Computing systems and networks:*

- Pupils will learn how to improve their mouse skills.

Art/DT:

We will be learning to draw and paint. We will be drawing lines, making waves and experimenting with media.

Music:

In music we will be learning to use music vocabulary. We will be learning about pulse and tempo.

PSHE:

In PSHE we will be learning about families and relationships.

RE:

In RE we will be learning about *Special Books*.

PE:



PE is on Wednesdays and Thursdays. Children should come to school in their PE kits or gym wear with the school colours.

Spellings:



Children should learn their spellings each week using their phonics skills.

Children will have a spelling test every **Monday**.

Spellings for the week are posted on Google Classroom and will be sent home with your child weekly.

Reading:

Children should practise reading for at least 15 minutes every day.

Times Tables:

- 1) $1 \times 2 = 2$
- 2) $2 \times 2 = 4$
- 3) $3 \times 2 = 6$
- 4) $4 \times 2 = 8$
- 5) $5 \times 2 = 10$
- 6) $6 \times 2 = 12$
- 7) $7 \times 2 = 14$
- 8) $8 \times 2 = 16$
- 9) $9 \times 2 = 18$
- 10) $10 \times 2 = 20$
- 11) $11 \times 2 = 22$
- 12) $12 \times 2 = 24$
