History:



This half term we have a history focus. We will be learning what it was like to be a child during the Tudor and Victorian times. We will compare their experience to now.

English:



We will be studying poetry. We will be looking at Poetry from a range of countries.

Children will develop their comprehension skills through daily guided reading sessions where they be looking at vocabulary questions, inference and prediction questions

The grammar concepts covered this half term will be conjunctions, Nouns adjectives, adverbs and similes. Children will also attempt to extend simple, compound and complex sentences.

Every day, the children will have a Times Table focus for maths just before lunch.

- Pupils will be learning how to be thoughtful when working on a collaborative document

We will be looking at Drawing and Sculptures

We will be learning Guitar

Friendships and managing hurtful behaviour and Bullying

RE:

We will be looking at worship across religions

French:

We will be looking at portraits
